CONDITIONS FOR EVENTS

1. **Championship Committee:** A Championship Committee, appointed by the SC & SBDGA, shall have sole management and control of the event. The Championship Committee reserves the right to: (a) fix and/or alter starting times, (b) in the event of bad weather, or for any other reason, either shorten the event or fix another day/venue, (c) vary any condition should they deem advisable, (d) reject any entry without assigning any reason therefore.
2. **Entries:**
 - 2.1 The Championships are open to junior male and female amateur golfers who have not attained the age of 18 years as at 01 August 2010.
 - 2.2 The field will be limited to 144 players – should entries be received in excess of this number the higher handicap amateur players will be balloted out and their entry fee refunded.
 - 2.3 Entries must be in the hands of the Secretary, SC & SBDGA, PO Box 64, Beerwah, QLD, 4519 by 4pm Monday 26th July 2010.
 - 2.4 The prescribed nomination fee of \$10.00 must accompany the entry form at the time of nomination and the form must be endorsed by an official of the player's home club.
 - 2.5 It is not recommended to send cash in the mail. The SC & SBDGA will not accept responsibility for cash sent in the mail that is not received.
 - 2.6 Once the draw is completed, there will be no refund of fees to players who withdraw from the event.
3. **Rules:** The Rules of Golf as adopted by the R&A Rules Limited will apply together with the GA Hard Card and any supplementary Local Rules as are approved by the Championship Committee. The Association's Code of Conduct applies to this event.
4. **Protests:** Protests must be lodged with the Championship Committee no later than 15 minutes after the conclusion of the player's round.
5. **Ties:** In the event of a tie for the Open Championship, play shall continue over such holes as the Championship Committee shall decide, players being eliminated hole by hole as they fail to maintain equality with others until the winner is determined. The breaking of ties for all other events / trophies will be determined by use of the Australian count-back system.
6. **Pace of Play:** Rule 6-7 will be strictly enforced. Each group must maintain its position on the course with respect to the group preceding it. Any group with a clear hole in front of it will be considered out of position. Penalties will be issued to individuals in such groups who by their pace contribute to such delay. Warnings may not be issued prior to penalties.
7. **Draw and Starting Times:** A draw for the Championship will be available on the District's website scsbdga@bigpond.com.au. As per Rule 6-3a, players shall start at the time laid down by the Committee. The penalty for breach of Rule 6-3a is disqualification. However, it is a condition of these Championships that, in the absence of circumstances which warrant waiving the penalty of disqualification as provided in Rule 33-7, if the player arrives at their starting point ready to play within five minutes of his starting time, the penalty for failure to start on time is two strokes instead of disqualification.
8. **Caddies:** Caddies are permitted during this event.
9. **Use of Motorised Vehicles:** During the tournament, competitors may NOT travel in or on any motorised vehicles unless authorised by the Championship Committee.
10. **Conduct and Etiquette:** The Championship Committee will apply a nil tolerance criteria during these Championships. Any competitor displaying inappropriate behaviour or bad language will be immediately disqualified from this event.
11. **Drug Testing:** All competitors are subject to drug testing by the Australian Sports Drug Agency for banned substances as laid down in Golf Australia's Doping Policy endorsed by Golf Queensland. Any competitor infringing this condition, or refusing to take a test, may be disqualified.
12. **Smoking:** Smoking and/or the use of other tobacco products is not permitted during this event.
13. **Dress Regulations:** It is a requirement that all players must comply with the minimum dress regulations of the host club.
